# 1. Introduction

With WP4 the CITYnvest project aims at setting up a capacity building programme in ten different European countries. One key element of the capacity building programme is the organisation of national events where innovative financing models are presented and their applicability is discussed with local experts and stakeholders.

The focus countries have been identified through joint efforts of the Climate Alliance Working Group on Financing and the experience gained by the consortium partners within the Covenant of Mayors initiative, and the capacity building needs identified. The ten selected focus countries are the following:

8. Belgium
9. Spain
10. Netherlands

In total 16 events have been organised in the ten selected countries: 15 including workshops, roundtable discussions and brainstorming sessions and 1 webinar.

## 2. Workshops in the focus countries

### 2.1 France

The national event in France took place on the 27<sup>th</sup> of September 2016 in Nantes. The workshop was organised by CEMR in collaboration with the French Association of the Council of European Municipalities and Regions with the support of Nantes Métropole. The event was attended by 41 participants (see participants list in annex).
